- a) Add 30px padding to all the paragraphs
- b) Add 2px solid green border and a 6px solid pink outline border to paragraph 2 - selector: id= "bord"
- c) Add a 10px red dotted border to <h1>header and a left margin of 30px
- d) Add 40px margin to <h2> header

**3.** Add the following to the order list:

- a) Left and Right :40px padding
- b) Top and Bottom:20px padding
- c) Margin left :50px
- d) Top border :2px dotted blue
- e) Bottom border:4px dotted orange
- f) Left border:3px solid green
- g) Right border: 6px solid red
