- b) Add a box shadow of 10px and 10px, and a 2px solid red border to the first paragraph – id="bordshadow"
- c) Add a text shadow of 3px,3px,7px , green and a blue font colour to the <h2> header
- d) Type the following inside the h3 curly brackets { }

animation-name:**myAnimation**;

animation-duration:4s;

animation-iteration-count:3;

border:4px dotted blue;

padding:20px ;

3. Save the file as CSS3.html
