

Exercise 1: Functions

1. Open Notepad and type the following:

```
<!DOCTYPE html>

<head >

<script>

//function code starts here

var base=10;
var height=5;
var area //value for area goes here;
document.getElementById("a").value=area;
//function code ends here
</script>

</head>

<body>

<form name="form1" //css inline style goes here >

<p>Area of a Triangle:</p>

//Input text box code goes here <br><br>

//Input button code goes here

</form>

</body>

</html>
```

2. Inside the `<script >` and `</script>` tags create a function called: `areaOfTriangle()`
3. Find the value of the area using the formula: $1/2 \times b \times h$
4. Inside the `<body>` and `</body>` tags create a text box with the `id="a"` and `value = " "`
5. Create a button called "Area " with an onclick event to call the function `areaOfTriangle()`
6. Add the following inline style to the `<form>` tag:
`style="border:5px groove black; padding:10px; width:250px"`
7. Save the file as `function.html`
